

A LOVELY NURTURING SCHOOL

Over 65% of boys from Christ Church Cathedral School, Oxford, achieved scholarships to leading senior schools in 2022
Christ Church Cathedral School (CCCS) was founded in 1546 by Henry VIII and maintains strong ties with Christ Church. CCCS is a small school, surrounded by Oxford colleges, with a non-selective co-ed nursery and prep school for boys aged three to 13.

As an independent school, its curriculum is forward thinking and designed to inspire and prepare pupils for entry into top senior schools. CCCS is a feeder to popular schools, including Eton, Harrow, St Edward's, Winchester and Magdalen College School. Its inspiring teachers inculcate in their pupils a love of learning, which is so often remarked upon by our senior schools, and the curiosity and verbal fluency of the pupils is clear to see. CCCS pupils love learning, a fact that informs their success.

Music is an important part of the school and is celebrated and encouraged, with many prep boys learning two instruments to a high level. CCCS provides choristers to sing in the internationally renowned Christ Church Cathedral Choir. Generous bursaries, which provide transformational opportunities, are on offer for Cathedral



choristers and can cover up to 100% of fees. Other boys are selected to sing for the chapels of Worcester College and Pembroke College during university term time, making CCCS the only school in the country with three professional boys' choirs.

The 10-acre games pitches on Christ Church Meadow give plenty of opportunities for every boy to represent the school in football, rugby and cricket. A new sports pavilion is due to open later this year.

Although primarily a day school, there's a boarding house in the main building of the school. Flexi-boarding is becoming increasingly popular.

CCCS offers a varied co-curricular programme, including sewing, real tennis and bell ringing. Underpinned by Christian values, pupils learn the importance of good manners, kindness and respect for others. Pupils look out for each other and parents comment on the welcoming feel of the school.
