The Co-ed Nursery is housed in a 16th century listed building, comprising four welcoming classrooms with a private garden. It is a special place, where the children's happiness and development are at its heart. The school is for boys aged 3 to 13 and offers boarding for Cathedral Choristers and flexi-boarding for day boys aged 8 to 13.

CCCS prides itself on exceptional academic and musical achievements. Over 60% of boys achieved scholarships and exhibitions to their chosen senior schools in 2022. The school supplies choristers to sing in the internationally renowned Christ Church Cathedral Choir.

The school values kindness, honesty and good manners and is very proud of its alumni.
