Christ Church Cathedral School (CCCS) offers a lovely supportive environment and inclusive community, where every child is noticed, challenged, and inspired to meet their potential.

Richard Murray has been the Headmaster of Christ Church Cathedral School since 2014. 'Being a small school, I have had the privilege of getting to know every child as an individual. Our small class sizes ensure pupils are encouraged to achieve their full capabilities. We pride ourselves in strong academic results; this year's leavers won a high number of scholarships and awards to some of the best local day schools and the country's leading boarding schools.'

As of January 2024, Pre-Prep is now co-educational, and along with our Montessori-inspired Nursery, welcomes boys and girls to benefit from all the opportunities CCCS has to offer. The Prep school (Years 3 to 8) remains all boys and continues to deliver an outstanding academic and musical education.

With over 150 music lessons every week, CCCS is renowned for its exceptional music tuition. The school boasts three outstanding

choirs, one world-famous. All Cathedral Choristers receive a bursary equivalent to two-thirds of the fees to support their education at CCCS. Cathedral Choristers are committed to boarding full-time. Flexi-boarding and occasional boarding are offered for day boys aged eight to 13.

CCCS' playing fields, bordering Christ Church and Merton Colleges, are among the most beautiful in the world and are where pupils play Rugby, Football, Cricket, and Athletics. In November, a new Sports Pavilion, replacing the former small timber structure, will be unveiled on Christ Church Meadow. The new Pavilion will be a multi-purpose facility for sports, outdoor learning, and social events.

'It will provide the opportunity to host more home matches and engage in community outreach events involving other local schools,' said Richard Murray. The school provides an extended local minibus service with two bus routes to and from school during the week, wrap-around care, extra-curricular and after-school clubs, including Chess, Robotics, Film Club, and more.
