

## **ACCESS TO RISKY AREAS OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS**

On the school site, the areas of potential risk are the playground (when being used by cars), the kitchens, St. Aldate's Quad and the driveway between Brewer Street and the Playground.

The playground is equipped with electronic gates which sound when cars are entering, warning pupils of the arrival of cars. During morning drop-off when the playground is busy, members of staff patrol all areas.

No pupil is allowed in the kitchens at any time and, during the day, no pupil is allowed into St. Aldate's Quad unless accompanied by an adult. Going to and from No. 1 between lessons, pupils go in class groups and there are teachers around at the time of lesson changes.

After the choristers have returned to school after Evensong, the gate between No. 1 and the main school site is locked.

The driveway is accessed via the electronic gate; no pupil is allowed through that gate unaccompanied.
